**CHLORMET ANNOUNCES NAME CHANGE**

**November 12, 2015 - Vancouver, British Columbia – Chlormet Technologies, Inc.** (“Chlormet” or the “Company”) (CSE: PUF) (Frankfurt: HR2P) (OTCPK: CHLMF) announces that the Company will change its name from Chlormet Technologies, Inc. to PUF Ventures Inc. to better reflect the direction of its business effective November 13, 2015.

The Company’s trading symbol will remain as “PUF” on the Canadian Securities Exchange and as “CHLMF” on the OTC Pink sheets and will change to “PU3” on the Frankfurt Stock Exchange. The CUSIP number for the Company’s common shares is 74530Q106 and ISIN is CA74530Q1063.

The Company has been advised by the Canadian Securities Exchange that the shares will trade under the new name effective at the opening of trading on November 13, 2015.
